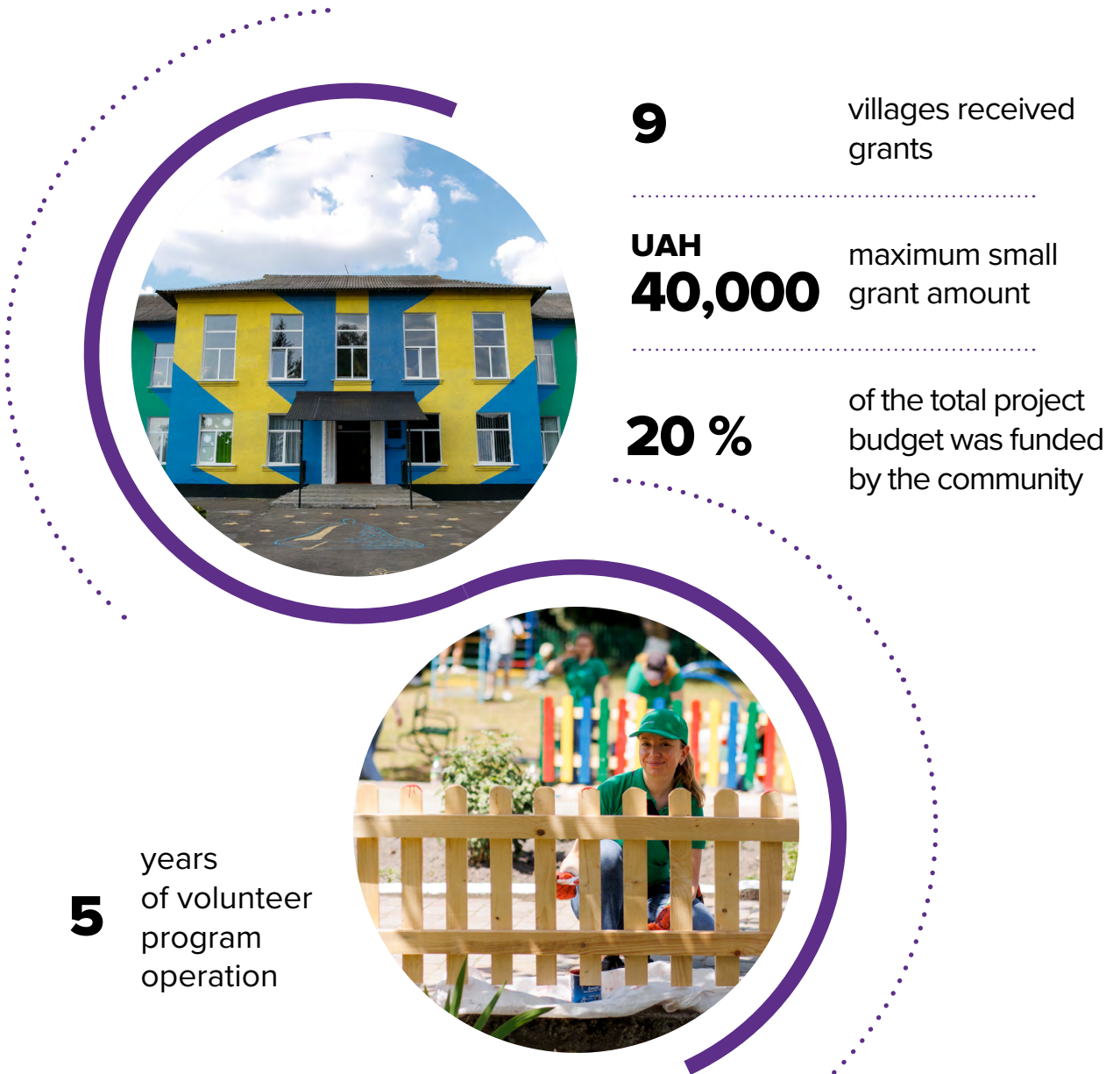
### The Linden Marathon

A social-ecological initiative under which the Company plants honey-bearing trees in settlements in Ternopil, Ivano-Frankivsk, Lviv, Chernivtsi, and Khmelnytskyi regions. The project supports beekeeping and community greening.

In 2024, Continental updated the initiative by focusing on creating recreational areas — establishing or restoring parks, squares, and alleys.

## Small Grants Competition

In 2024, the Company introduced a new format of interaction with rural communities — participation in a competition to receive small grants for implementing local projects. Applications were thoroughly reviewed, and the best initiatives were carried out as part of corporate volunteering. Together, Company employees and local residents achieved various positive changes in communities: they renovated a school facade in Velyki Zahaytsi, installed playgrounds in Oliiv and Kupyn, purchased and installed outdoor exercise equipment in Oryshkivtsi, repaired a bus stop in Pohirts, modernized a public space in Ruda, built a volleyball court in Pavliv, and set up a tent camp at a youth center in Velyka Radogoshch.



## Corporate Volunteering

Corporate volunteering is an integral part of Continental's internal culture. Every year, employees from various clusters and offices dedicate one workday to a common cause — improving the communities where Continental operates.

One of the most notable examples in 2024 was the support of residents in Zaliztsi community in Ternopil region. Company employees and community members joined efforts to enhance the social infrastructure in Reniv and Mylne villages.

## Online English Language Courses

An educational program offering English language learning for the children of shareholders and Company employees, providing an opportunity to acquire or improve foreign language skills. Participants include children aged 7 to 17, and the training is conducted as eight-month online courses. Professional teachers conduct two-hour weekly lessons, opening up new educational opportunities for children from villages and small towns.

## The Easter Rainbow

On the eve of Easter, Continental, together with scouts from Plast, traditionally organizes Easter egg painting workshops for schoolchildren in all its operating regions. During these sessions, children not only master the art of decorating Easter eggs but also learn about Ukrainian traditions and cultural heritage. The workshops take place in educational institutions and at Company sites.

## The Smart Garden

An educational and social initiative by Continental that helps schoolchildren gain practical experience in growing agricultural crops and learning business fundamentals.

The project aims to engage children and youth in agriculture, showcase modern agricultural technology prospects, and teach gardening, entrepreneurship, financial literacy, and volunteering. Leading Ukrainian and international companies, as well as the Government of the Kingdom of the Netherlands, have partnered in the initiative.

The project is implemented in two formats: The Smart Garden engages rural schoolchildren in growing vegetables on their own or school plots and in greenhouses, while The Smart Garden: Microgreens allows children from small towns and regional centers to learn how to grow microgreens on specialized racks with automatic irrigation in schools. The harvested produce is sold, with part of the proceeds allocated to support Ukraine's Defenders.

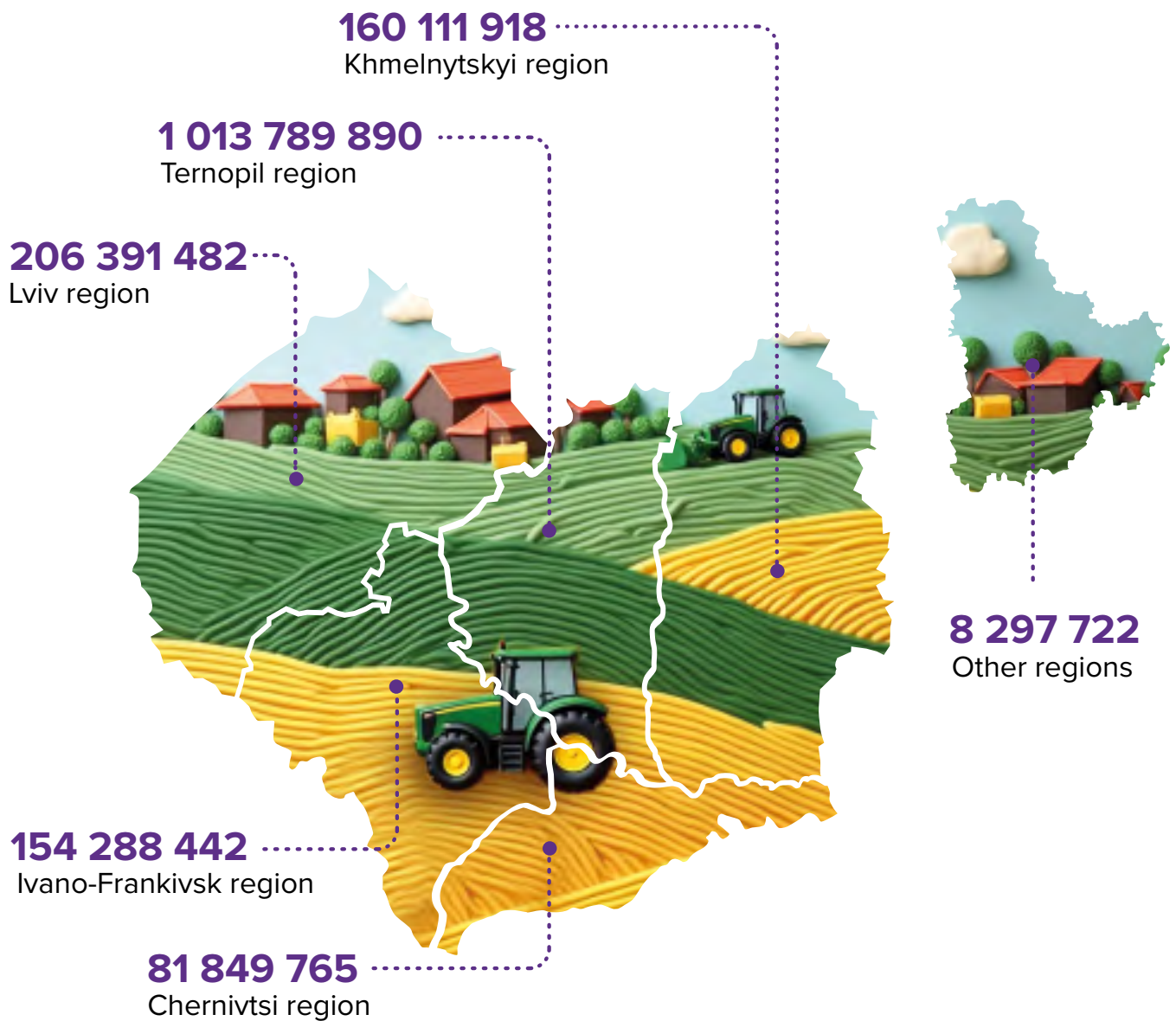

# IMPROVEMENT AND INFRASTRUCTURE



**25 communities** received various equipment for landscaping and territory maintenance. A total of **UAH 528,000** was allocated for the purchase of brush cutters, lawnmowers, chainsaws, trimmers, fuel, and spare parts.



**UAH 3.2 million** was allocated for the purchase and transportation of crushed stone for road filling and pothole repairs, with an additional **UAH 581,000** spent on asphalt mix.



Pothole repairs were carried out in **78 local districts**.



Over **UAH 1.6 million** was directed toward the installation, repair, and restoration of water supply systems. The Company helped improve water supply infrastructure in **25 settlements**.



**7 bus stops** were repaired and restored.



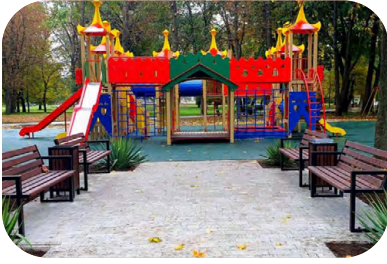
A total of **UAH 421,800** was allocated for the purchase of paving stones for landscaping.

## AMONG THE IMPLEMENTED PROJECTS



### Landscaping in Shumsk

*Shumsk Town, Shumsk Territorial Community, Ternopil Region*

A modern playground complex was installed in the city center to create a safe and engaging space for children's development and recreation. This became possible through cooperation between Global Communities, local authorities, and Continental. The Company funded the landscaping work and the playground installation.



### Pothole Repairs on Roads in Velyke Kolodno and Vykhopni

*Velyke Kolodno Village, Zhovtantsi Territorial Community, Lviv Region*

With the Company's support, current pothole repairs were carried out on local roads of public use: Kolodentsi – Staryi Yarychiv and Hrabovets – Vykhopni – Zhovtantsi. The road surface restoration will enhance safety and comfort for residents and drivers using these routes daily. Funds were allocated for the purchase of asphalt concrete mix for the repair work.



### Purchase of a Mini Tractor-Mower for the Halych Sports Club

*Halych Town, Halych Territorial Community, Ivano-Frankivsk Region*

To ensure proper maintenance of sports and recreational areas, a modern maneuverable mini tractor-mower was purchased. This specialized equipment will help the local sports club Halych efficiently maintain public spaces, creating comfortable conditions for sports activities and leisure.



### Urban Improvement Projects in Horodok

*Horodok Town, Horodok Territorial Community, Khmelnytskyi Region*

As part of the city's improvement initiatives, a fence near the Migration Service building was repaired, and paving stones were installed on the premises of Horodok Lyceum No. 4. These improvements enhanced the aesthetic appeal and convenience of the urban environment. The Company financed the required building materials and construction work.



### Construction of a River Crossing Over the Siret River

*Lukavtsi Village, Berehomet Territorial Community, Chernivtsi Region*

To improve transportation accessibility and convenience for local residents, a bridge crossing over the Siret River was built in the village. The new bridge ensures a safe crossing and passage, especially during periods of high water levels. Continental allocated funds for the purchase of essential pipes and timber materials.



**14 Walks of Fame** established in territorial communities. A total of **UAH 473,000** was allocated for these projects.



**14 cultural and social institutions** renovated, including cultural centers, community houses, libraries, and co-creation hubs.



**7 cultural institutions** received musical equipment, while **6** were provided with multimedia devices, including projectors, laptops, televisions, and more.



**UAH 243,000** was allocated to support cultural and artistic events in the communities.



More than **UAH 100,000** was directed toward the restoration of monuments in the Company's areas of operation.

## AMONG THE IMPLEMENTED PROJECTS



### Renovation of the Town House of Culture

*Skalat Town, Skalat Territorial Community, Ternopil Region*

The Skalat Town House of Culture underwent major improvements: the stage flooring was renewed, and the sewage system was repaired. The Company allocated UAH 78,400 for stage restoration and an additional UAH 41,000 for construction materials for drainage system repairs. These upgrades were especially welcomed by the members of the Perlyna amateur dance ensemble. The project not only ensures comfortable conditions for performances but also promotes cultural development in the community. The modernized stage and improved infrastructure create opportunities for new artistic initiatives and youth engagement in the arts.



### Purchase of Musical Equipment for the Community House

*Stilsko Village, Trostianets Territorial Community, Lviv Region*

Community houses serve as gathering places for residents, providing opportunities for creative expression, discussions, and artistic events. Proper technical equipment is crucial for their operation. When the Stilsko Community House needed sound equipment, they turned to Continental for support. The Company responded to the request and funded the purchase of high-quality musical equipment.



### Procurement of Construction Materials for the Restoration of St. Nicholas Monument

*Mylne Village, Zaloztsi Territorial Community, Ternopil Region*

Continental contributed to the restoration of the historic statue of St. Nicholas in Mylne by funding the purchase of construction materials. This initiative was led by local residents who deeply value the monument's spiritual and historical significance. The restoration preserved not only the statue but also key elements of the community's cultural heritage.



### Roof Replacement for the Village Club

*Yuryntsi Village, Sataniv Territorial Community, Khmelnytskyi Region*

With the support of Continental, the village club in Yuryntsi underwent roof repairs, with nearly UAH 280,000 allocated for the project. The renovated space now serves as a hub for community meetings, educational activities, and social initiatives.



### Roof Renovation for the Village Club and Medical Facility

*Obych Village, Shumsk Territorial Community, Ternopil Region*

The building housing the village club and first aid station in Obych was in urgent need of repairs. The roof had begun leaking, posing a threat to the structure. Continental provided funds for the renovation in 2021, but the full-scale invasion delayed the project. In 2024, following community requests, additional funds were allocated for construction materials. The completed roof renovation has safeguarded the building, ensuring a functional space for cultural and medical services. The restored facility will serve the community for years to come, demonstrating the importance of investing in local infrastructure.



**33 educational institutions** received various household and office equipment.



To ensure comfortable learning conditions, new furniture was purchased for **8 educational facilities**.



Windows and doors were replaced, renovations were carried out, and landscaping was completed in **104 schools**.



To ensure a safe learning environment, bomb shelters were set up in **6 schools**.



**53 schools** received sports equipment to support physical education and sports activities.

## AMONG THE IMPLEMENTED PROJECTS



### Installation of a Surveillance System and High-Speed Internet at Rosokhach Lyceum

*Rosokhach Village, Horodenka Territorial Community, Ivano-Frankivsk Region*

Rosokhach Lyceum was equipped with high-speed internet and a video surveillance system. The company allocated UAH 50,000 for this initiative, enhancing the learning process and improving lesson delivery. Additionally, funds were directed toward minor renovations and the purchase of a brush cutter for maintaining the school grounds. Continental also supports the local community with equipment and assists the local volunteer fire brigade.



### Replacement of Windows at Novosilka Village School

*Novosilka Village, Pidhayski Territorial Community, Ternopil Region*

Thanks to Continental's support, UAH 167,500 was allocated to install new metal-plastic windows in Novosilka village school. Windows were replaced in two classrooms, the dining hall, and corridors, making the premises brighter, cozier, and warmer.



### Courtyard Improvement at Tovstenke Gymnasium

*Tovstenke Village, Kolyndiany Territorial Community, Ternopil Region*

Before the start of the school year, the courtyard of Tovstenke Gymnasium was renovated. Continental allocated UAH 223,000 for paving stones. This is not the Company's first contribution to the school — previously, it funded window replacements.



### Asphalting of the Kindergarten Courtyard

*Yurkyvtsi Village, Yurkyvtsi Territorial Community, Chernivtsi Region*

The surrounding area plays a vital role in children's development, especially in kindergartens. The Yurkyvtsi Preschool recently completed asphalt paving work, ensuring a safe and comfortable environment for its young students.



### Replacement of Windows and Doors at Babyna Gymnasium

*Babyna Village, Novyi Kalyniv Territorial Community, Lviv Region*

Continental helped improve conditions at Babyna Gymnasium by installing new doors and replacing windows before the start of the school year. Enhancing educational infrastructure remains a priority within the company's corporate social responsibility program.



### Purchase of Furniture for Students at Podvirne Lyceum

*Podvirne Village, Mamalyha Territorial Community, Chernivtsi Region*

Proper material and technical resources are essential for a high-quality education. Thanks to this initiative, students at Podvirne Lyceum now have new desks and chairs, ensuring a more comfortable learning experience.



**UAH 880,000** was allocated to support various sports events, including football, volleyball, and chess tournaments.



**16 Plast scouting camps and events** were held with the company's support.



**15 football teams** received new uniforms and sports equipment worth over **UAH 300,000**.



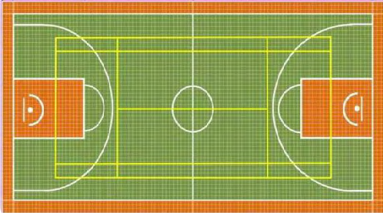
**7 children's playgrounds** were installed to promote active recreation for kids.

### Installation of Modular Sports Flooring

*Ispas Village, Vyzhnytsia Territorial Community, Chernivtsi Region*

A modern modular surface is being installed on a sports field in Ispas, making basketball and tennis more comfortable. The versatile construction will allow easy adaptation for different sports. This upgrade will enhance training and competition conditions while improving athlete safety by reducing injury risks. The opening is planned for 2025.



### New Children's Playground Opened

*Velyke Kolodno Village, Zhovtantsi Territorial Community, Lviv Region*

A new children's playground was installed, featuring a slide, swings, and a carousel — everything for fun and engaging outdoor activities. This initiative aims to create a safe and enjoyable space for children's development. The new area will promote social interaction and encourage kids to spend more time outdoors.



### Outdoor Fitness Equipment Installed

*Oryshkivtsi Village, Kopychyntsi Territorial Community, Ternopil Region*

A modern outdoor fitness zone was established, allowing residents to improve their physical fitness and lead an active lifestyle. The accessible and easy-to-use equipment is suitable for people of all ages and fitness levels. This initiative aims to popularize a healthy lifestyle and enhance the community's sports infrastructure.



### Installation of a New Children's Play Complex

*Kupyn Village, Horodok Territorial Community, Khmelnytskyi Region*

Through a small grants competition, the Vodohrai Kindergarten in Kupyn received a new playground, making children's leisure brighter and safer. The updated area, featuring a slide and freshly painted swings, creates a comfortable and fun space for kids to play and develop. This project showcases how community involvement and grant programs can positively transform children's environments.



### Sports Equipment and Uniforms for Local Teams

*Lviv, Ternopil, Chernivtsi, and Khmelnytskyi Regions*

Football teams across the regions where the Company operates received new uniforms and sports equipment last year, ensuring better training conditions. The updated gear will not only enhance performance but also strengthen team spirit. This valuable support contributes to the development of local sports and motivates players to achieve new heights.



Communities across **61 local districts** received funding for various spiritual development projects.



**28 churches** received construction and renovation materials, including roofing supplies, domes, facade repair materials, heated flooring, doors, and windows.



**17 church courtyards** were improved with paving stones, gravel, and fencing materials.



**12 churches** were equipped with new furniture, technical equipment, and interior elements.



**8 religious and spiritual events** were financially supported.

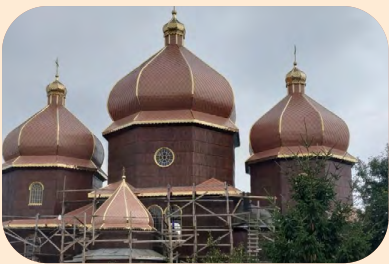
## AMONG THE IMPLEMENTED PROJECTS



### Church Benches for the Saints Peter and Paul Church

*Velyki Birky Village, Velyki Birky Territorial Community, Ternopil Region*

The Saints Peter and Paul Church in Velyki Birky received new benches and seating funded by the company, totaling UAH 200,000. The newly built church, consecrated in 2019, continues its ongoing development. With the addition of comfortable benches, worship services have become more accessible for elderly parishioners, individuals with limited mobility, and families with small children.



### Co-Financing Roof Repairs for the Beheading of John the Baptist Church

*Silets Village, Dobrotvir Territorial Community, Lviv Region*

The church roof renovation project in Silets required 1,000 m<sup>2</sup> of sheet metal for its three main domes — a task too costly for the local community to handle alone. Thanks to corporate social responsibility efforts, the renovation is now underway, with completion expected by summer 2025.



### Paving of the Dormition of the Blessed Virgin Mary Church Courtyard

*Panka Village, Storozhynets Territorial Community, Chernivtsi Region*

The Dormition of the Blessed Virgin Mary Church serves as a gathering place for both older and younger generations. With youth programs and a Sunday school, the busy courtyard needed improvements. The Company funded the paving project, making the space safer, more organized, and aesthetically pleasing.



### Traditional Ukrainian Choir Attire for the Protection of the Blessed Virgin Mary Church

*Novosilky Village, Peremyshliany Territorial Community, Lviv Region*

A long-cherished dream came true for the choir members of the Protection of the Blessed Virgin Mary Church in Novosilky. Thanks to the Company support, the choir performed in new traditional Ukrainian attire during the church feast celebration. This initiative is more than just material support — it's an investment in the parish's cultural heritage, inspiring pride and continuity of tradition for future generations.



**68 healthcare facilities** across five western regions of Ukraine received support from the Company.



**7 medical institutions** underwent renovation work, including building repairs, restroom upgrades, window and door replacements, and the purchase of construction materials.



**53 medical facilities** received essential medical inventory, equipment, and office technology, with a total investment of over **UAH 600,000**.



**4 sets of furniture** were provided for hospitals, outpatient clinics, and feldsher-midwife stations, including new furnishings for a physical therapy office and a rehabilitation center.



As part of a centralized medical project, **45 healthcare facilities** were equipped with specialized kits, including mobile medical bags stocked for field examinations and medical gowns for staff.

### Renovation of the Primary Healthcare Center

*Stupky Village, Baikivtsi Territorial Community, Ternopil Region*

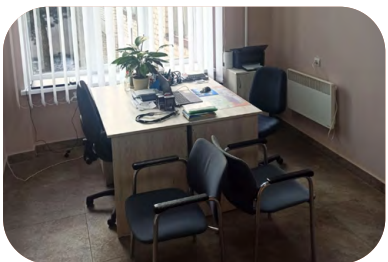
The capital renovation of the Primary Healthcare Center in Stupky has been completed after five years of work. Thanks to the joint efforts of socially responsible businesses and local authorities, the premises have been modernized, new medical equipment has been purchased, and the range of services has been expanded. Now, patients can visit a dentist, cardiologist, and otolaryngologist, as well as undergo biochemical tests at the laboratory. Additionally, there is an option for home visits for patients in need.



### Purchase of an Electric Scooter for Medical Workers

*Ternova and Tynna Villages, Novo Dunaivtsi Territorial Community, Khmelnytskyi Region*

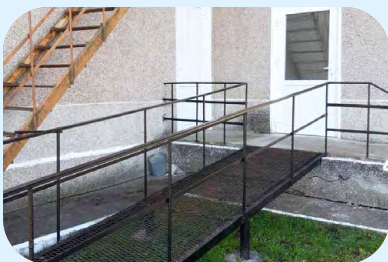
Medical workers in Ternova and Tynna have received a modern electric scooter. Since they provide care for residents in villages, convenient transportation has become a necessity. This update will allow doctors to reach patients faster and improve the accessibility of medical services for local communities.



### Renovation of the Family Medicine Clinic

*Pidvolochysk Village, Pidvolochysk Territorial Community, Ternopil Region*

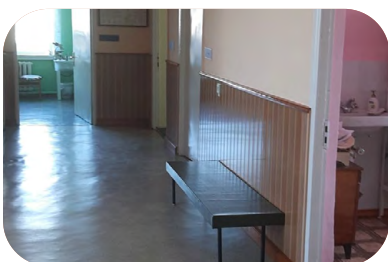
Renovation work has been carried out at the General Practice — Family Medicine Clinic in Pidvolochysk. As family doctor services are in high demand, the consultation room was fully updated, including flooring replacement, ceiling and wall repairs, and the installation of a new sink. These improvements create a more comfortable environment for both doctors and patients. Modern and well-equipped medical facilities contribute to the overall quality of healthcare services, making the clinic more accessible and pleasant for visitors.



### Installation of a Ramp and Restroom in the Paramedic and Midwifery Center

*Ostrivets Village, Horodenka Territorial Community, Ivano-Frankivsk Region*

A new ramp and restroom have been installed at the Paramedic and Midwifery Center in Ostrivets, making it more accessible and comfortable for visitors, especially those with limited mobility and mothers with strollers. The facility relocated to its current premises in 2022 and has since been equipped with everything necessary to ensure high-quality medical services. Previously, the Company also supported the center by funding renovation work and water supply installation.



### Renovation of the Paramedic and Midwifery Center

*Podvirne Village, Mamalyha Territorial Community, Chernivtsi Region*

The Paramedic and Midwifery Center in Podvirne has received essential upgrades thanks to the joint efforts of the community and the Company, which financed the purchase of construction materials. The renovation was carried out by local residents and the administration. This healthcare facility plays a crucial role in the lives of villagers, who frequently seek medical assistance. As a result of the project, the center has become more comfortable and convenient for patients, marking a significant contribution to the development of village healthcare.
